Covid -19 Risk Assessment for EGM Parish Council on 20 May 2021

The meeting will be held outdoors in the grounds of The Firs, Low St, Thornton-le-Clay.

The 4 councillors to be present will be seated 2m apart with their backs against the wall. Public will stand on 3 sides around them, socially distanced & wearing masks if they wish. If more than one row of people then extra rows must stand 2m behind the first row. The first row of people will be at least 3m or more away from councillors.

Entrance to the meeting is through the 12m wide gateway into the grounds. There are no pinch points less than 12m wide on the way to where the meeting is to take place. Exit will be via the same way after the meeting. Whilst most people will walk to the meeting, any cars will be parked on the public roadside.
